Narrator I: And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And lo, the angel of the Lord came (*music begins*) upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them and they were sore afraid. And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds said one to another, Let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made known unto us.
