I completed US Air Force Officer training (OTS) in the Spring of 1981. The course was 12 weeks long - we were "90-day wonders" and commissioned as Second Lieutenants (2Lt). As we marched around the campus we were serenaded with recordings of Sousa marches - in the "standard" tempo of 120 paces per minute, called "Quick Time". We also occasionally marched "Double Time" which was 180 paces per minute. (There were of course other march tempos, but we did not use them in that training.) I thought then, and still do, that many of our LDS Hymns could be excellent march tunes if properly performed to "Quick Time" or "Double Time" tempo. There are so many such Hymns that it was hard for me to choose only a few for treatment in this movement!
